2. Based on Ephesians 1-2, how would you describe Jesus as a roommate in the home of your heart? Demanding? Imposing? Judgmental? See also Romans 5:1 and Romans 8:1.
3. Paul seems to struggle with how to measure the immeasurable love of Christ in 3:18-19. He wants us to know a love that surpasses knowledge. How are we to do that? Are we to do it alone?
4. What life-change—previously unimaginable—has God worked in your life? What life-change do you want Him to bring about in your future?
