4. Who do you have in your life (right now) that encourages you to focus on Christ and love/honor your spouse?

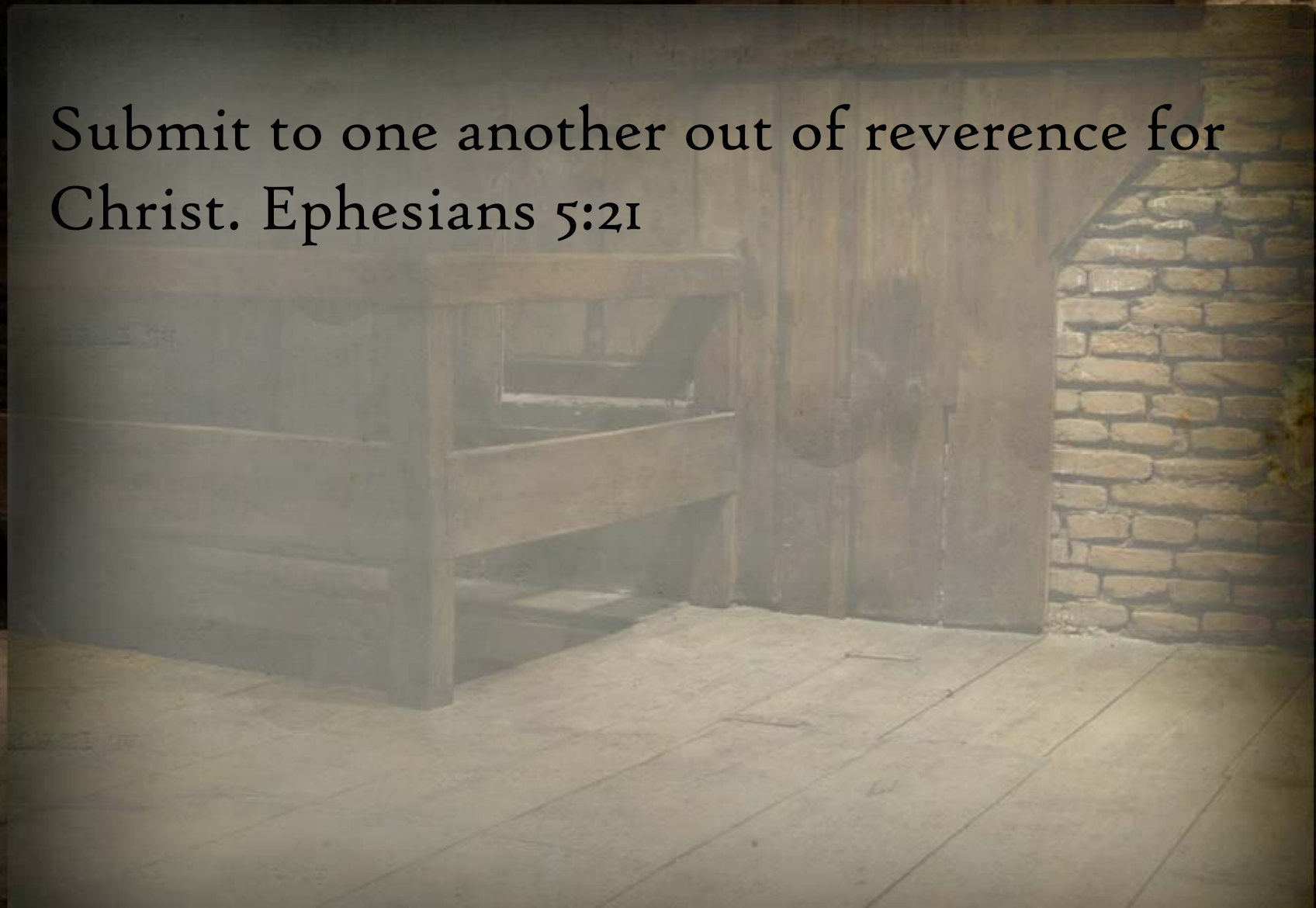



## Application for Husbands:

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.
